

PERRYOPOLIS BOROUGH COUNCIL
MONTHLY MEETING
JUNE 10, 2026

A monthly meeting of the Perryopolis Borough Council was called to order by Council President Bill Compliment on June 10, 2026, at 7 p.m. in Council Chambers at the Perryopolis Borough Building.

Present were Mayor Charles Petrosky, Council President Bill Compliment, Vice President Wayne Nicholls, Niel Costabile, Danielle Costabile, Frank Masney, Mark Plewniak, Solicitor Melinda Dellarose, and Colleen Pontoriero Secretary.

Absent was Jacob Shoaf.

Also present were Paul Brittan, (Daily Courier), John Lunt, Bob Zundel, and Denny Madorma.

A Motion to accept the minutes from the May Council Meeting was made by Wayne Nicholls, 2nd by Mark Plewniak—All Yes—Motion Carried.

McMillen Engineering shared with Council the Land Development Plan for Perry Township Volunteer Fire Departments addition that is being built.

A discussion was held about appointing Mark Kirshner as the Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator for Perryopolis Borough. Mr. Kirshner has his Hazmat EOC Certifications. Steve Kontaxes would still be the EMA Director.

A Motion to appoint Mark Kirshner Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator for Perryopolis Borough was made by Niel Costabile, 2nd Danielle Costabile—All Yes—Motion Carried.

Perry Township Fire Department asked for the Borough to dig a trench behind Perry Drug for their tug of war event the week of their convention.

A Motion to dig the trench for the Fire Department was made by Frank Masney, 2nd by Mark Plewniak—All Yes—Motion Carried.

Niel Costabile informed Council that the traffic calming regulations have changed. He said Liquid Fuels money will still be received for roads with speed bumps, and he would be willing to pay for them on Janet Street.

Mr. Costabile proposed two Ordinances one for noise and one for vehicles parked in yards and on streets.

Solicitor Melinda Dellarose informed Council that she did receive the two proposed Ordinances but didn't have time to review them before the meeting.

A discussion was held about E-Bikes and Scooters. A meeting will be held with the community on Saturday June 13, 6 at 11 a.m. at the Fire Hall to discuss safety and what the laws are in Pennsylvania regarding E-Bikes and Scooters.

A Discussion was held about allowing E-Bikes and Scooters on the walking track to keep them off the streets.

Council will allow the E-Bikes and Scooters on the walking track if they don't interfere with the walkers.

A Motion to pay the Bills Due and Payable was made by Niel Costabile, 2nd by Frank Masney—All Yes—Motion Carried.

Mayor Petrosky will not be attending the Mayors Convention this year and he would like to donate the \$1,000.00 budgeted to Perryopolis VFW.

A Motion to donate \$1,000.00 to the VFW with an invoice from them telling what the money will go toward was made by Niel Costabile, 2nd by Frank Masney—All Yes—Motion Carried.
