

PERRYOPOLIS BOROUGH COUNCIL
MONTHLY MEETING
MAY 13, 2026

A monthly meeting of the Perryopolis Borough Council was called to order by Council President Bill Compliment at 7 p.m. on Wednesday May 13, 2026, in Council Chambers at the Perryopolis Borough Building.

Present were Mayor Charles Petrosky, Council President Bill Compliment, Vice President Wayne Nicholls, Niel Costablie, Jacob Shoaf, Daniel Costabile, Frank Masney, Mark Plewniak, Solicitor Melinda Dellarose, and Colleen Pontoriero, Secretary.

Also present were John Lunt, Devin White, and Denise and Brian Cavrak.

Danille Costabile pointed out a few errors on April 1, 2026, minutes. (Her motion to not approve the hiring of Police Officers Gary Farrell and Timothy Lemley was because she didn't have enough information to vote).

Also, Mark Plewniak did not make a motion to cut the grass at Washington Run Park. He only agreed.

Frank Masney's motion to approve the circle project was not completely what he said and that the whole motion should be included in his motion.

A Motion to accept the April Minutes with the corrections listed above was made by Danielle Costabile, 2nd by Wayne Nicholls—All Yes—Motion Carried.

Devin White from Parks and Recreation informed council of a few updates with parks. She said that the grass is being taken care of. She also informed Council that they are in the process of having a smaller pavilion built to host smaller events.

Devin White told Council that Rachel Sager will attend a Council Meeting after the bricks have been removed to see what she can do with them.

Frank Masney told Council that the bricks are not going to be picked up and loaded onto pallets as he was informed before. He was told that that would be too costly so now they will be scooped up and piled at a location at the salt shed.

A discussion was held about how to inform the public, but nothing was decided.

Danielle Costabile asked about Frank Masney being on the Zoning Hearing Board.

A discussion was held about Frank Masney being on the Zoning Hearing Board since he is on Borough Council. Frank Masney said that he verbally resigned from that board when he was sworn into office. No replacement has been found for that position.

Danielle Costabile asked why all of Borough Council was not invited to a meeting held at the borough building on April 20, 2026.

Frank explained that it was not a formal meeting, it was a committee meeting about 6 roads being bonded. He explained that day was the first he heard about 6 roads being bonded and was concerned about possibly losing the circle project if they didn't need to use the circle. It was just a spur of the moment thing not a planned meeting.

A.J. Boni asked Penn Dot to postpone the removal of the bricks in the circle until after the Fireman's event in July.

A Motion to sign the excess Maintenance agreement with Fay as presented was made by Mark Plewniak, 2nd by Jacob Shoaf—All Yes—Motion Carried.

A Motion to hire Matt Alekson and Lori Amos as part-time Borough Police at \$23.00 per hour and after 6 months' probation \$24.50 per hour was made by Danielle Costabile, 2nd by Jacob Shoaf—All Yes—Motion Carried.

A discussion was held about safety concerning E-Bikes, Electric Scooters, and Golf Carts.

A Motion to hold a town meeting sometime in June at the Fire Hall and getting share the road signs was made by Mark Plewniak, 2nd by Niel Costabile—All Yes—Motion Carried.

A resident requested to Ryan Warner's office a school bus sign be installed at 116 Rehobeth Church Road. Penn Dot will install the sign, but the Borough needs to submit the request.

A Motion to request the school bus sign for 116 Rehobeth Road was made by Jacob Shoaf, 2nd Mark Plewniak—All Yes—Motion Carried.

A Motion to pay the Bills Due and Payable was made by Frank Masney, 2nd by Danielle Costabile—All Yes—Motion Carried.

POLICE –Frank Masney discussed working with Dennis Heath to get the license plate readers up and running and getting a new laptop for the police.

Council told them these complaints take time but assured them that their complaint was being investigated by code enforcement.
